## **Agreement of Service**

This agreement is entered into the 1st day of June - 2019 Between S.V.PATHY, BMW-Facilitator, (Technical Director) Muthuvayal, Paramakudi Taluk, Ramnad District And

Ramnad Clinical Laboratory, 16C AKS Complex, R.R. Sethupathy Nagar, Ramanathapuram.



S.V. PATHY, Facilitator, Bio Medical Waste Management Project, RAMNAD District, Authorisation No. JCEE(M) MDU / BMW-903.

- 1. Whereas the Facilitator shall setup a common facility in accordance with the Bio Medical waste (Management and Handling) Rules, 1998 & 2016, for collection, transportation, treatment and disposal of the bio-medical waste generated by the users and
- 2. Whereas the Users generating bio-medical wastes which need to be managed in accordance with the Bio-medical waste (Management and Handling) Rules, 1998 & 2016.
- Whereas facilitator offers to provide the services required for the users to be complied with the above said rules, on a user-pay on monthly basis according to the quantity of waste fixed by IMA.
- The Rate will be reviewed and revised every year based on increase in Diesel Price, Vehicle Maintenance, Electricity Charge, Labour wages, Wholesale price index jointly by the IMA and the facilitator in to account of the fluctuations in the above.
- The facilitator and TNPCB will make periodic inspections of the users regarding the collections and segregations of Bio-medicals waste etc.,
- 6. The users shall segregate the waste in accordance with the Bio-medical waste (Management and Handling) rules 1998 & 2016.
- 7. Facilitator shall collect the wastes from the users place at times and frequency mutually agreed by both parties. The time duration may be 24 to 48 hours.
- 8. Facilitator shall be liable for violation under the Bio-Medical Waste (Management and Handling) rules 1998 & 2016 from the time the waste is handed over to facilitator.
- 9. Facilitator shall meet all the rules and regulations stipulated by the TNPCB.
- 10. Facilitator promises to keep high standards of pollution control.
- 11. All complaints shall be attended to in the shortest possible time, i.e., 48 hours.
- 12. Facilitator shall send bill for the preceding month by the 3<sup>rd</sup> of the next month and the same shall be paid by cash/DD/Cheque.
- 13. The Facilitator to ensure all the needles are destroyed effectively at the sources, as directed by the Tamilnadu of pollution control board.
- The HCE shall ensure that all the syringes disposed shall not have any part of the needle.
- The Facilitator shall collect the Bio Medical waste from, one particulars Point, of the HCE every day at a specified time & to suit the convenience of collection mechanism of the Facilitator and mutually agreed by both the parties. The HCE shall cooperate with the Facilitator personnel for adherence of the time schedule as agreed and in all aspects of collection and Transportation of Bio-Medical waste at their premises.
- 16. Facilitator shall stop services if payments are not made within 20 days from the date of billing.
- 17. Both the parties hereby undertake to adhere to this "Agreement of service". for the period from 01.07.2019 to 31.03.2020
