DETAILS

The Deputy Advisor (Unani Medicine) and Director, Central Council for Research in Unani Medicine, Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Government of India, New Delhi, has stated that the Government of India have proposed to start a Regional Research Institute in Unani at Madras and that they require a building 8,000 sq.ft. in extent with reasonable provision for future expansion. The proposed Institute at Tamil Nadu will be under the Central Council for Research in Unani Medicine. It will form a nucleus for the development of Unani research and education in the Southern states and hence has to play the role of a pioneering institution in the South. The proposed Institute will have the following activities:

1. Clinical Research with GP and D.P. as basis
2. Mobile clinical Research Unit
3. Survey of Medicinal Plants Unit
4. Research scheme on Serpaning or contractive agents.

2. The Deputy Advisor Unani, Government of India, has also reported that, in its meeting held on 30.4.1979, the Standing Finance Committee of the Central Council for Research in Unani Medicine has approved the recommendation of the Scientific Advisory Committee regarding the establishment of a Regional Research Institute for Unani Medicine at Madras and has requested this Government that the building may be made available to the Council to start its activities.

3. The Director of Indian Medicine, who was consulted in the past, has stated that the Institute may be accommodated in the building No. 56, West Mada Church Street, Mylapore, which is vacant consequent on the shifting of the Central Road Transport Organisation to Guindy. The said building is a old one which required repairs and renovation has requested the orders of the Government for carrying out these modifications.

4. The Central Public Works Department has estimated for carrying out general repairs to the building at 56, West Mada Church Street, Mylapore, Madras-13 including electrical installations at a cost of Rs. 1.25 lakhs and has requested sanction of the Government.

5. The Government approves the proposals of the Director of Indian Medicine and the Chief Engineer(Building) accordingly executed the plan and estimates for an expenditure of Rs. 1.25 lakhs (Rupees One lakh and twenty five thousand only) towards carrying out repairs to the building at 56, West Mada Church Street, Mylapore, Madras-13 including electrical installations for establishing the Regional Research Institute for Unani Medicine at Madras.

6. The Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine is requested to hand over the building to the Deputy Advisor and Director, Central Council for Research in Unani Medicine, Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, New Delhi, duly repaired for the establishment of the above Institute.

7. This expenditure should be debited to the relevant Public Works Department head of account under "283. Housing & Government Residential buildings-AC Public Works-Non Plan".

8. A copy of the letter H.O.No.119/P/1/V/79 dt.25.5.79 or the Central Council for Research in Unani Medicine is sent to the Director of Indian Medicine, Madras for information.

9. The plan and estimates are returned to the Chief Engineer, Public Works Department (Hill-type), Madras-5. He is requested to carry out the repairs and also acknowledge the receipt of this order.

10. This order issued with the concurrence of Secretary, Public Works Department and Accountant General vide H.O.No.185 SWM/79-1 dt.6.6.79 and vide H.O.No.1689/P/1/V/79 dt.6.6.79 respectively.
