

- ... OSA objective is in operating position. You
clock wise and counter-clockwise until you are familiar with this position stop.
Open the iris diaphragm approximately half way
Place the slide in the stage slide holder securely
View through the eyepieces and without disturbing the coarse adjustment
setting.

• Proper Care of the Microscope:

- Use both hands when carrying the microscope, one firmly grasping the arm of the microscope, the other beneath the base. Avoid sudden jabs.
- To keep the microscope and lens systems clean
- Never touch the lenses. If the lenses become dirty, wipe them gently with lens paper.
- Never leave a slide on the microscope when it is not in use.
