AGREEMENT OF SERVICE

This agreement is entered on 06.09.2021 between M/s.Pondicherry Solidwaste Management Company Private Limited., functioning at R.S.No.275/2A, & 276/2B2A1, T.Pudaiyur, Srirangam Post, Veppur Taluk, Cuddalore District - 606 302 and having its registered office at R.S.No.79/5 & 80/2, Rajeev Gandhi Land Mark, Thuthipet, Villianur Commune, Puducherry - 605 502, here after called as PSMPL and also Party-A, represented by Mr. N. Srinivasa Prabhu, Director & CEO.

And

The Director, Directorate of Medical and Rural Health Services, No.258, DMS Complex, 3rd Floor, Anna Salai, Teynampet, Chennai - 600 006. (Hereinafter called as "Party-B")

1. Whereas (Party-A) has established a Common Treatment Facility in accordance with the Bio Medical Waste (Management and Handling) Rules, 2018, for Collection, Transportation, Treatment and Disposal of the Bio-medical wastes generated by Government "Health Care Establishments".
2. Whereas Government Hospital in Cuddalore, Villupuram, Kallakurichi and Perambalur coming under The Joint Director of Medical and Rural Health Services are generating Bio-medical Waste which needs to be managed in accordance with the Bio-Medical Waste (Management and Handling) Rules, 2018 of Govt. of India.

Terms and Conditions:

1. Whereas (Party-A) offers to provide the services required for Collection, Transportation of all Bio-medical Waste (including empty plastic saline bottles, plastic bottles and plastic cans from the hospitals) which are primarily collected from the source points within the hospitals and stored in a common storage room by the concerned hospital and its final disposal at the Common Bio-Medical Waste Treatment Facility as per Biomedical Waste (Handling and Management) Rules, 2018, to be complied by Party-B with the above said rules on a "user-per-principle" at

2. The above rate is inclusive of all costs towards collection and transportation of biomedical waste from the hospitals and its proper end disposal as per the Bio-Medical Wastes (Management and Handling) Rules, 2018 of Govt. of India, on Daily Basis and once in 48 hour basis (as quoted by Party-A and agreed by the authority for periodicity of collection).
3. The empty plastic saline bottles, plastic bottles and plastic cans collected along with the biomedical waste from the hospitals should be weighted in kilograms in different type of categories and mentioned in the bidding document and should be recorded in the register available in the hospital and a receipt in triplicate on number of kilograms and category of empty plastic saline bottles, plastic bottles and plastic cans lifted on that particular day from that particular hospital should be handed over by Pondicherry Solidwaste Management Company Private Limited (Party-A) to the nodal person designated for implementation of infection control and biomedical waste management. However, for payment, the weight of empty plastic saline bottles, plastic bottles and plastic cans will be excluded. All other items irrespective of the color coding shall have to be paid against the certified quantities of disposal.
4. If the collected bio medical waste including empty plastic saline bottles, plastic bottles and plastic cans from the hospitals are not lifted as mentioned above by Pondicherry Solidwaste Management Company Private Limited (Party-A), then the payment to the service provider, the Common Bio-Medical Waste Treatment Facility by, The Joint Director of Medical and Rural Health Services, Cuddalore, Villupuram, Kallakurichi and Perambalur and the concerned persons of the Cuddalore, Villupuram, Kallakurichi and Perambalur district (under the jurisdiction of Party-B) will be paid at the rate of $1/n^{\text{th}}$ of the total biomedical waste collected on that particular day of the visit of service provider, the Common Bio-Medical Waste Treatment Facility, where "n" is the day of visit of the service provider.
5. If the payment against the submitted bills (which are submitted in full and complete shape) is delayed beyond 21 working days from the date of submission, an interest @ 6% may be paid to service provider, the Common Bio-Medical Waste Treatment Facility by The Joint Director of Medical and Rural Health Services, Cuddalore, Villupuram, Kallakurichi and Perambalur (Under the jurisdiction of Party-B).
6. Complaints (if any) shall be attended to in the shortest possible time, (48 hrs) by the service provider under the jurisdiction of Pondicherry Solidwaste Management Company Private Limited (Party-A) and the client under the jurisdiction of State Nodal Officer, Directorate of Medical and Rural Health Services, Teynampet, Chennai – 600 006 (Party-B) (Authorised signatory of the agreement).

- The client under the jurisdiction of **The Joint Director of Medical and Rural Health Services, Cuddalore, Villupuram, Kallakurichi and Perambalur** (under the jurisdiction of Party B) has the right to enter the operational premises of service provider under the jurisdiction of **The Joint Director of Medical and Rural Health Services, Cuddalore, Villupuram, Kallakurichi and Perambalur** (under the jurisdiction of Party B) at any time to ascertain the final disposal of biomedical waste collected from their hospital.
8. Agreement can be terminated by giving one month notice by both the parties, client and service provider.
 9. Any dispute, controversy, or claim arising out of or relating to this agreement shall be settled by arbitration by the appellate authority **The Director, Directorate of Medical and Rural Health Services, Teyyanampet, Chennai - 600 006.**
 10. **Pondicherry Solidwaste Management Company Private Limited (Party-A)** and **The Director, Directorate of Medical and Rural Health Services No.258, DMS Complex, 3rd Floor, Annasalai Teyyanampet, Chennai - 600 006.** (Party B) here by undertake to adhere to this "Agreement of Service" for a minimum period of **THREE YEARS** (from the date of approval).
 11. The list of Government Hospitals and the periodicity of collection of biomedical waste from the hospitals in each district is given in **Annexure-1.**

BMW - CTF - Terms and Conditions:

1. The price indicated is firm and includes all cost towards manpower, resource requirement like all equipments, consumable, management/monitoring services and resource requirement for administration etc., as per the terms and conditions of the bidding document and any other taxes and duties, royalties as applicable.
2. The **GST is Nil** for this service as indicated in the bidding document and it may be subject to change as per government notifications from time to time.
3. Number of hospitals shall vary from time to time. But the rate shall not exceed the above range till the contract period.
4. **PERIOD OF CONTRACT:** The contract period will be for **THREE YEARS** from the date of letter of intent received.

Role and Responsibilities of Pondicherry Solidwaste Management Company Private Limited (Party-A)

1. Prior planning of the coverage area and its operation with neat timings should be informed to the head of the Government Hospitals listed in **Annexure-1** of this agreement.
(Dean / Medical Superintendent, Hospital Superintendent / Chief Medical Officer / In-charge Medical Officer / Regional Administrative Medical Officers, whoever the case may be)
2. Any change in the plan should be intimated well in advance to the head of the Government Hospital (Dean / Medical Superintendent, Hospital Superintendent / Chief Medical Officer / In-Charge Medical Officer / Regional Administrative Medical Officers, whoever the case may be).
3. **Pondicherry Solidwaste Management Company Private Limited (Party-A)** is responsible for the safe transportation of the Bio-Medical Waste from the Hospital premises to the Common Treatment Facility as per the norms prescribed by **TNPCB**. **Pondicherry Solidwaste Management Company Private Limited (Party-A)** will arrange an alternate vehicle during the period of vehicle breakdown for the transportation.
4. **Pondicherry Solidwaste Management Company Private Limited (Party-A)** should keep proper records for the quantity of Bio-Medical Waste lifted under different categories from hospital on **48 Hours** basis in **Cuddalore, Villupuram, Kallakurichi and Perambalur District.**
5. The quantity (weight) of Bio medical waste lifted from each hospital should be entered in a register maintained in that particular hospital and should be endorsed by the concerned hospital authority who has been designated for this work.

6. **Pondicherry Solidwaste Management Company Private Limited (Party-A)** is responsible for following all statutory rules and regulations prescribed by Tamilnadu Pollution Control Board prevailing on the day for the service and for keeping and producing all the records required on this regard by the authorities.
7. **Pondicherry Solidwaste Management Company Private Limited (Party-A)** will make periodic inspections of the Cuddalore, Villupuram, Kallakurichi and Perambalur (list of hospital under the jurisdiction of Party B) regarding collection and segregation of Bio-Medical Waste (Management and Handling) Rules, 2018 of Govt. of India.
8. **Pondicherry Solidwaste Management Company Private Limited (Party-A)** shall provide the training once in three months free of cost about segregation of bio medical waste as per color coding of the present BMW (M) rules 2018, collection of waste in color coded bags as well as occupational safety in management and handling of Bio-Medical Wastes.
9. **Pondicherry Solidwaste Management Company Private Limited (Party-A)** shall send the bill in full and complete shape for the preceding month, by the 5th of the next month and the same shall be paid **The Joint Director of Medical and Rural Health Services, Cuddalore, Villupuram, Kallakurichi and Perambalur** (under the jurisdiction of Party-B) through DD or Cheque drawn in favour of **Pondicherry Solidwaste Management Company Private Limited (Party-A)** payable at Cuddalore, Villupuram, Kallakurichi and Perambalur within 21 working days from the date of submission.

Rules and Responsibilities of The Joint Director of Medical and Rural Health Services, Cuddalore, Villupuram, Kallakurichi and Perambalur.

1. The Dean / Medical Superintendent, Hospital Superintendent / Chief Medical Officer / In-Charge Medical Officer / Regional Administrative Medical Officers, whoever the case may be should identify a responsible / nodal staff in their hospitals, for handling over the collected biomedical waste from the hospital to **Pondicherry Solidwaste Management Company Private Limited (Party-A)** and the same should be communicated to **Pondicherry Solidwaste Management Company Private Limited (Party-A)** with their local contact number with a copy marked to their respective directorates.
2. The payment against the submitted bills (which are submitted in full and complete shape) will be processed and paid through DD or Cheque in favour of **Pondicherry Solidwaste Management Company Private Limited (Party-A)** payable at Cuddalore, Villupuram, Kallakurichi and Perambalur within 21 working days from the date of submission.
3. I also abide by the rules as per the TNMSC letter of intent dated 06.09.2021 & subsequent amendments/addendum thereof.
4. Printed color coded bio medical waste collection bags shall have to be procured only from the facilitator at the below mentioned rates.


