Agreement of Services

This agreement is entered on the O1 day of May 2022 between Aseptic Systems Bio Waste having its registered office at B1, 'C' Colony, Perumalpuram, Tirunelvell - 627 007, (Hereinafter called as "Party A") represented by itsAuthorized Signatory Mr.N.Murugan.

B.The Deputy Director of Health Services Tenkasi Health Unit District, (Herein after called as " Party B")

- Whereas Aseptic Systems Bio Medical waste Management Company (party A) has
 established aCommon Treatment facility in accordance with the Bio-Medical Waste
 (Management and Handling) Rules, 2016, for collection, transportation, treatment
 and disposal of the bio-medical wastes generated by Government "Health Care
 Establishments".
- Whereas Teukasi, Comes Under The Deputy Director of Health Services Tenkasi
 Health Unit District. (listof hospitals0. under the jurisdiction of party B) are
 generating Bio-Medical wastes which need to managed in accordance with the Bio
 Medical Wastes (Management and Handling) Rules, 2016 of Govt. of India.

Terms and Conditions:

- 1. Whereas ASBMWMCO.(Party A) offers to provide the services required for Collection, Transportation of all Biomedical Waste (including empty plastic salinebottles, pouches and plastic cans from the hospitals) which are primarily collected from all the source points within the hospitals and stored in acommon storage room by the concerned hospital staff and its final disposal at the common Bio-Medical Waste Treatment Facility as per Biomedical Waste (Handling and Management) Rules, 2016, to be complied by party B with the above said rules on a "user per principle " at INR:68/ kg[Rubees Sixty Eight/Kilogram Only] on a daily basis and INR:68/kg[Rubees Sixty Eight/Kilogram Only] at once in 48 Hour Basis. Payment shall be made monthly.
- 2. The above rate is inclusive of all costs towards collection and transportation of biomedical waste from the hospitals and its proper end disposal as per the Bio Medical Wastes (Management and Handling) Rules, 2016 of Govt. of India, on Daily Basis or oncen in 48 Hour Basis (as quoted by party A and agreed by the authority for periodicity of collection) inclusive of all statutory duties, taxes.,[Currently GST is not applicable]
- 3. The empty plastic saline bottles, pouches and plastic cans collected along with the biomedical waste from the hospitals should be weighed in kilograms in different type of categories as mentioned in the bidding document and should be recorded in the register available in the hospital and a receipt in triplicate on number of kilograms and category of empty plastic saline bottles, pouches and plastic cans lifted on that particular day from that particular hospital should be handed over by ASBMWMCO. (Party A) to the nodal person designated for Implementation of Infection Control and Biomedical waste Management. However for payment, the weight of empty saline bottles, plastic pouches and cans will be excluded. All other items irrespective of the color codding shall have to paid against the certified quantities of disposal
- 4. If the collected biomedical waste including empty plastic saline bottles, pouches and plastic cans from the hospitals are not lifted as mentionedabove by ASBMWMCO (party A), then the payment to the service provider, the Common Bio-Medical Waste Treatment Facility by The Deputy Director of Health Services Tenkasi Health Unit District, under the jurisdiction of (party B) will be paid at the rate of I/nth of the total biomedical waste collected on that particular day of the visit of service provider, the Common Bio-Medical Waste Treatment Facility, where "n" is the day of visit of the service provider.

- Agreement can be terminated by giving one month notice by both the parties, client and service provider.
- Any dispute, controversy, or claim arising out of or relating to this agreement shall be settled by arbitration by the Appellate authority, Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health Systems Project.
- 10. ASBMWMCO. (Party A) and The Deputy Director of Health Services Tenkasi Health Unit District (party B)here by undertake to adhere to this "Agreement of Service" for a minimumperiod of THREE YEARS (from the date of approval)
- 11. The list of Government hospitals and the periodicity of collection of biomedical waste from the hospitals in each district is given in annexure I.

- 1. Prior planning of the coverage area and its operation with near timings should be informed to the head of the Government Hospitals listed in annexure 1 of this agreement. (Dean / Medical Superintendent, Hospital Superintendent / Chief Medical Officer / In-Charge Medical Officer / Regional Administrative Medical Officers, Whoever the case may
- 2. Any change in the plan should be intimated well in advance to the head of theGovernment Hospitals listed in annexure 1 of this agreement (Dean / Medical Superintendent, Hospital Superintendent / Chief Medical Officer / In- Charge Medical Officer / Regional Administrative Medical Officers, Whoever the case may be)
- 3. ASBMWMCO.(Party A) is responsible for the safe transportation of the Bio Medical Waste from the hospital premises to the Common Treatment Facility as per the norms prescribed by TNPCB, ASBMWMCO.(Party A) will arrange alternative vehicle during the period of vehicle breakdown for the transportation.
- 4. ASBMWMCO(party A) should keep proper records for the quantity of Bio Medical Waste lifted under different categories from each hospital listed in annexure 1 of this agreement on daily basisor once in 48 hours basis...
- 5. The quantity of (weight) of Bio Medical Waste lifted from each hospital should be entered in a register maintained in that particular hospital and should be endorsed by the concerned hospital authority who has been designated for this work.
- 6. ASBMWMCO(Part A) is responsible for following all statutory rules and regulations prescribed by Tamil Nadu Pollution Control Board prevailing on the day for the services and for keeping and producing all the records required in this regard by the authorities.
- 7. ASBMWMCO(party A) will make periodic inspections of the The Deputy Director of Health Services Tenkasi Health Unit District (list ofthe hospital under the jurisdiction of(party B) regarding Collection and Segregation of Bio-Medical Waste (Managementand Handling) Rules 1998 of Govt. of India.
- 8. ASBMWMCO (party A) shall provide the training once in three months free of cost about segregation of bio medical waste as per color coding present BMW (M) rules2016; collection of waste in colour coded bags as well as occupational safety in management and Handling of Bio Medical Wastes.

ASBMWMCO (party A) shall send the bill in full and complete shapefor the preceding month, by the 5th of the next month and the same shall be paid by The Deputy Director of Health Services Tenkasi Health Unit District, under the jurisdiction of (Party B) through DD or Cheque drawn in favour of Aseptic Systems Bio Medical Waste Management Company (party A) payable at Tirunelveli within 21 working days from the date of submission.
