2. The ESIC has separately applied to Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Government of India to grant exemption under sub regulation (1A) of regulation 8 of Medical Council of India Post Graduate Medical Education Regulations for establishing exclusive new Post Graduate Institute of Medical Science and Research for training in Basic Sciences for the proposed ESI-PGMSR, KK Nagar and Ayanavaram, Chennai respectively as per the above noted Medical Council of India Regulations for Post Graduate Medical Education regulations, 2001 and its amendment 2005.

3. The Director General, ESIC, New Delhi has requested to grant permission to start certain Post Graduate Degree/Diploma courses at ESIC Hospitals at K.K.Nagar and Ayangaram.

4. The Director of Medical Education was directed to make necessary arrangement for causing inspection of ESIC Hospitals at K.K.Nagar and Ayangaram and send inspection report along with specific recommendation on the point of desirability and feasibility for starting Post Graduate Degree and Diploma Courses. The Director of Medical Education constituted Department wise inspection team. The inspection teams have conducted inspection and submitted their reports.

5. The Government after verifying the desirability and feasibility, convey permission/Essentially Certificate to start the following courses in ESIC Hospitals at K.K.Nagar and Ayangaram, subject to the condition that Consent of Affiliation from the Tamil Nadu Dr.M.G.R. Medical University should be obtained, 50% of the seats should be filled up by the candidates of Tamil Nadu through the Selection Committee of the State, necessary infrastructural facilities (staff are provided as per Medical Council of India norms) Regulations for admission to Post Graduate courses, necessary exemption from Central Government under sub regulation (IA) of regulation 8 of Medical Council of India Post Graduate Medical Education Regulations for establishing exclusive new Post Graduate Institute of Medical Science and Research for training in Basic Sciences for the proposed ESIC PGMSR, K.K.Nagar and Ayangaram, Chennai and the approval of Medical Council of India Government of India should be obtained before the courses are started.

In continuation to this Council's Letter of Intent dated 02/07/2013 and with reference to your letter dated 04/07/2013, I am directed to convey the approval of the Board of Governors for establishment of new medical college at Chennai, Tamil Nadu in the name and style of "ESIC Medical College, Chennai" by Employees' State Insurance Corporation, New Delhi with an annual intake of 100 (One Hundred) students with prospective effect i.e. from the academic year 2013-14 u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956, as amended.

This permission of the Board of Governors, Medical Council of India for establishment of new medical college and admission of students is initially for a period of one year. It will be renewed on yearly basis on verification of achievements of annual target set out in the project report. This process of annual renewal of permission will continue till such time the establishment of medical college and expansion of hospital facilities are completed as per the norms of Medical Council of India.

In addition to above, this is further to inform you that while making admissions of your college to MBBS course it shall be ensured that:

- (i) No admission is permitted beyond the sanctioned intake capacity;
- (ii) Selection of Students to the Medical College is in accordance with the requirements laid down in the Graduate Medical Education Regulations, 1997;
- (iii) The admission process for the academic year 2013-14 has to be completed in accordance with the time schedule indicated in the Graduate Medical Education Regulation, 1997, as amended. No admission is permitted beyond the cut-off date.

It shall be incumbent upon the Medical College that the information relating to admissions should be submitted within a fortnight of closure of admissions to the Council. Any failure to submit the information within this time limit would be construed that the admissions in the College were not in accordance with the statutory requirements, thereby enabling the Council to proceed in accordance with law against the College.

Sir,

I am directed to inform you that an assessment to verify the compliance submitted by the college authorities on the deficiencies pointed out in the assessment report (5th & 6th March, 2018) with regard to recognition/approval of ESIC Medical College, Chennai, Tamilnadu for the award of MBBS degree (100 seats) granted by The Tamilnadu Dr. M G R Medical University Chennai u/s 11(2) of the IMC Act, 1956 was carried out by the Council Assessors on 29th August, 2018. The assessment report (29th August, 2018) along with previous assessment report (5th & 6th March, 2018) was considered by the Board of Governors at its meeting held on 11/11/2018 and decided to recommend to the Central Government for recognition/approval of ESIC Medical College, Chennai, Tamilnadu for the award of MBBS degree (100 seats) granted by The Tamilnadu Dr. M G R Medical University Chennai u/s 11(2) of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Board of Governors further decided that the attention of the institute be drawn to Sections 8(3)(2), 8(3)(3) & 8(3)(4) of the Establishment of Medical Colleges Regulations (Amendment), 2010 (Part II) dated 16th April 2010 and act accordingly at appropriate time, which reads as under:-

8 (3) ...

(2) The recognition so granted to an Undergraduate Course for award of MBBS degree shall be for a maximum period of 5 years, upon which it shall have to be renewed.

(3) The procedure for 'Renewal' of recognition shall be same as applicable for the award of recognition.

(4) Failure to seek timely renewal of recognition as required in sub-clause (a) supra shall invariably result in stoppage of admissions to the concerned Undergraduate Course of MBBS at the said institute."

In view of above, you are, therefore, requested to issue necessary notification at the earliest recognizing ESIC Medical College, Chennai, Tamilnadu for the award of MBBS degree when granted on or after Feb., 2018 by The Tamilnadu Dr. M G R Medical University Chennai.

A copy of the assessment report is enclosed herewith.

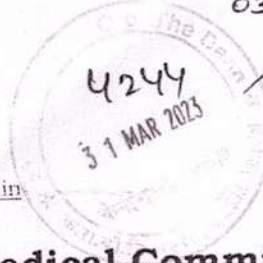




